Helpful wine hints about our list

In Australia it is very common to find wine lists that list the name of variety rather than listing the name of the wine region.

Reading the label on the bottle is like reading a wine list.

Below are a few hints on reading a wine label.



Read the Wine Region first with the Appellation/Classification (VDT, IGT, DOC, DOCG), then name of the wine or Estate name, producer and vintage year.

For the Australian wine the Appellation or Classification is different, you have Zone, Region and Sub-region. Because we want to give more importance to the Wine Region, you will read the Wine Region first, then name of the wine or Estate name, producer and vintage year. You will see also that before the State's name there is the Zone name, which is an area of land that contains the famous Wine Region.

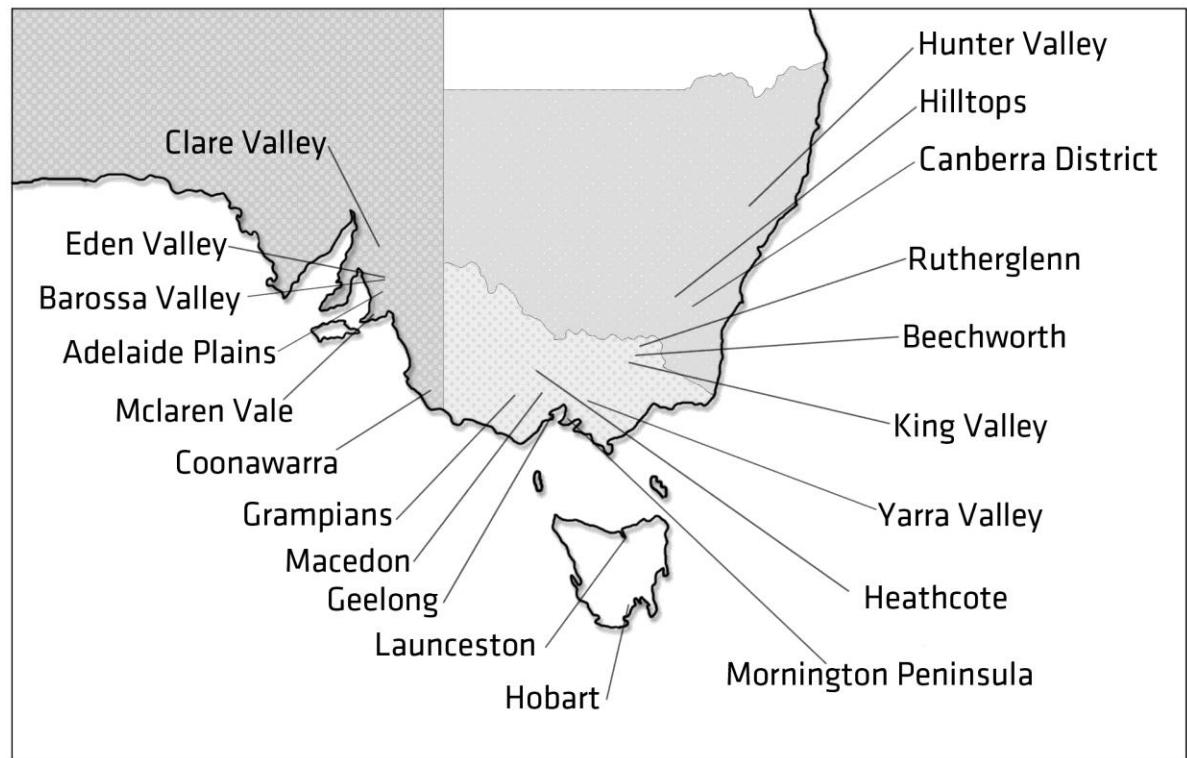
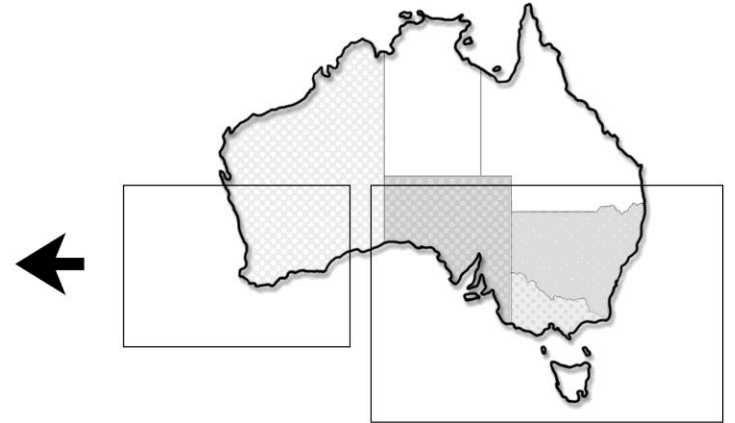
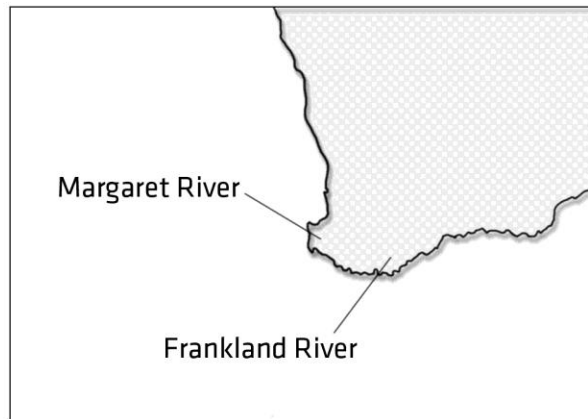
